

GENERAL RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS

STABLING: A stall chart will be posted at the show office. Stalls will be available on Wednesday, June 21, 2017 – 9AM. Tuesday arrivals will be charged an additional \$15.

ENTRIES: Entries must be RECEIVED by noon on Friday, June 16, 2017. Post Entries will be accepted with a LATE Fee of \$10 per horse.

BEDDING: Bedding order must be included on the Entry Blank. Changes and additions to your Bedding Order must be received by Friday, June 16, 2017, 6 PM.

Additional Bedding CAN BE ORDERED AT THE Show Office after June 21, 2017. The exhibitor must pick up the bedding at the Shavings Stalls.

GENERAL RULES

1. ACADEMY CLASSES are open to Saddleseat, Hunt Seat and Western Seat riders. Academy classes will be split if there are more than six entries.
2. Helmets will be allowed in any class without penalty.
3. COGGINS – A valid negative Coggins must be available to be shown to the show secretary.
4. All entry sheets must be signed by an authorized adult.
5. Northeast Georgia Foothills Charity Horse Show Inc. is sanctioned by ASHAG, ASAC, GMHC, ETSA and **ASHA**.
6. RETURNED CHECKS – All checks returned for insufficient funds will be charged a \$50.00 handling fee.
7. BEDDING REQUIREMENT – All horse stalls must have a minimum of 2 bags of bedding. There will be a fine of \$35 for all horse stalls that do not meet this requirement. The fine is assessed by Chipcopee Woods Agriculture Center and is determined by park personnel at various times of the day.
8. DECLINED ENTRIES – The management of Northeast Georgia Charity Horse Show reserves the right to decline or return any entry fee and/or stable fee before or during the horse show, without being liable for compensation. No entries will be accepted if there is an outstanding balance from a previous Northeast Georgia Foothills Charity Horse Show.
9. HOLDS – There is a two minute limit on holds. Requests should be made at the show office or with the Paddock Master/Gate Master. Once the class is called, the gate will remain open for no more than two minutes.
10. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to check in at the paddock with the Paddock Master.
11. All entries must qualify by entering, showing, and being judged in a qualifying class.
12. Jackpot Classes do not have to qualify.
13. Jackpot Payout
\$100 ADDED MONEY plus 75 % of entry fees
1st 40%, 2nd 30%, 3rd 20%, 4th 10% - 5th and 6th ribbons
Checks will be mailed to exhibitors

14. MANAGEMENT'S DECISION IS FINAL – Anyone entering the show grounds agrees to abide by the rules and decisions of the Chicopee Woods Agriculture Center and Northeast Georgia Foothills Charity Horse Show Management.

Chicopee Woods Rules and Regulations

1. All vehicles must be kept in designated parking areas
2. Aisles and roadways around barns must be kept open all times due to fire and emergency regulations.
3. Only licensed operators will be permitted to operate vehicles. Golf carts included.
4. All pets must be kept on a maximum of a 6 foot leash at all times. No pets are allowed in any office at any time.
5. No alcoholic beverages allowed on premises.
6. All RVs must park and hook up in designated RV hook-up areas.
7. Gas, electric or propane heaters, propane tanks and hot plates are prohibited in stall areas at all times.
8. Electrical extension cords must be 12 (twelve) gauge and 3 (three) wire and prong negative ground type.
9. All manure and used shavings removed from stalls must be placed in specified areas. Not in garbage cans.
10. No smoking in buildings, rest rooms or stable area.
